- **THESIS**: Sentence with subject of paper and opinion. Usually comes at the end of the Introduction.
- **TOPIC SENTENCE**: First sentence in a Body paragraph. It contains the subject and opinion about the topic of the paragraph.
- **CD = Concrete Detail**: Specific details examples, facts, descriptions, illustrations, support, proof, evidence, quotations, paraphrasing.
- **CM = Commentary**: Your opinion or comment about something insight, analysis, interpretation, inference, response, evaluation, examination, explication, and clarification.

Concluding Sentence: last sentence in a paragraph that gives a finished feeling to it.
